Community Standards & Signature

WE'RE A COUNTER-CULTURAL COMMUNITY!

Because Bodenseehof is a unique environment, we have some policies which, quite honestly, are not normal for some of us.

Since we sometimes have a waiting list for entrance, we want to make sure that the students who do come are in full agreement with our standards when they arrive.

The intent of our community standards is to set aside certain things during this short period in order to be open to all the Lord has for us. Some of our students are intensely longing for a new beginning and have appreciated an environment free of some of the things that have been a distraction or even a problem for them in the past.

We can appreciate the fact that our community life standards may not be familiar to your culture and church setting, but because of our unique environment we have set these standards so that Bodenseehof can be a positive, supportive environment for growth.

It is, after all, only 6 months long, and we have found in the past that students have appreciated the community life standards after they arrived and understood the context in which they are lived out. We'll take time to explain our reasoning behind them when you arrive and things will become more clear.

SCHEDULE AND PROGRAM

We ask our students to respect the daily time schedule and participate in all official program elements—including lectures, assignments and some small practical duties. Because of the restrictions on space in the dorm and the intensity of the schedule, we also ask the students to honor quiet hours in the dorm by 23:00 during the week and 24:00 on weekends. We want to ensure that all students are allowed enough rest during their stay with us.

SUBSTANCE USE

We do not allow the use of alcohol, narcotics or tobacco on or off campus during the time Bodenseehof is in session. During the term breaks and travel weekends, students are free to exercise their own discretion.

RELATIONSHIPS

We do not allow romantic physical affection between male and female students during school. It is also our experience that serious romantic relationships invariably detract from the usefulness of the course for those concerned as well as the other students—so we ask our students to exercise discipline and discretion in this regard.

MEDIA

Because of the nature of our program, we do not allow students to watch movies or TV shows on their electronic devices at any time other than during travel weekend and Christmas break.

Also, some who might be distracted by computer games may wish to uninstall them and leave them at home in order to be more open to the Lord's teaching. Many students have appreciated taking a break from these distractions when they come to us. In either case, we will not tolerate any computer games with inappropriate subject matter.

DRESS / APPEARANCE

We ask that our students exercise modesty and discretion in appearance during their time with us.

We also have some additional guidelines which are specific to our community and context:

For church services and meals on Sundays, we ask our students to dress up (smart casual/formal).

In General: With the exception of women's earrings, piercings may not be initiated during your time at Bodenseehof. Similarly, while here, you may not initiate a tattoo in an area where it could be seen. This requirement is out of sensitivity to the varied outreaches and guests we will be involved with.

We ask that students be fully clothed (including shirts) while in public spaces on campus, including during exercise and sports.
